## The Sedanka Spring Creek is home to some of the most exciting trout fishing on Earth!

THE FLY SHOP team discovered this magnificent spring creek only a decade ago, bubbling out of the Kamchatka lava beds like a miniature Hat Creek. Nearly every inch of it is wadeable and every one of the 30 miles of spring-fed creek is jammed with a strain of ferocious, beautifully-colored rainbows.

Most Sedanka trout run 18-24 inches and rise to dry flies all day long during July, feeding on a literal carpet of large stones and mayflies. The action with mouse patterns is good beyond description. Fish over 2 feet long are not uncommon, and most are older than any rainbow found in North America rivers.

Fishing begins a stone's throw from the 3 comfortable camps situated about every 7 miles along the Sedanka. Anglers spend several days in each of the cabin camps, wading and sight fishing for trout than haven't seen a fly or lure in three seasons. The quality of the camps is a direct contrast to the wilderness that separates the Sedanka from civilization, and the only method of transportation to and from Petropavlovsk (several hundred miles away) is by the ultra-reliable fleet of MI-8 helicopters.

Cost of the 9-day, 9-night trip is \$6,975. Space is limited to half a dozen anglers each week of the month long season.

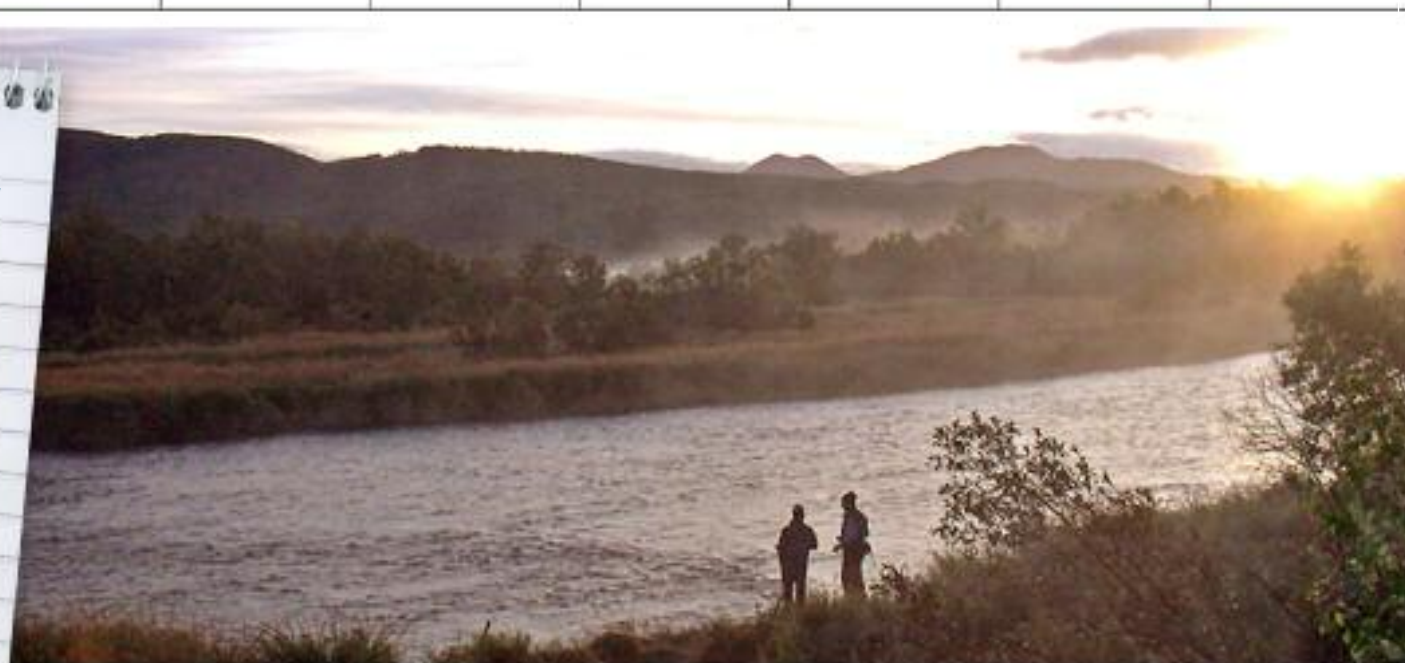
